You are completing the BTEC Tech Award in Performing Arts. It has three components. Components one and two are internal assessed units that count for 30% each. They focus on developing skills, knowledge and understanding of the performing arts. Your third component is a devised unit that is externally assessed and counts for a final 40%. Component 3 has 4 sections; three logs – ideas, skills and evaluation; and then a final performance.

Component 3: You will be given the opportunity to work as part of a group to create a workshop performance in response to a given brief and stimulus from the exam board.



Performing Arts top tips for Revision



- Practice your logs before your formal written sessions
- Ensure your log notes are in bullet form but contain the information that is key for the grading criteria
- Rehearsing for 10 minutes each day is better than a 1 hour session
- Remember to warm up for singing, vocals or dance practice
