Uniform and Equipment Reminders

Students in Years 7 -11 will need a suitable school bag in which to carry their equipment/books. Please ensure your child does not return to school after the summer break with any form of facial piercing – facial piercings are not allowed and students attending with facial piercings in the new academic year will be placed in internal exclusion. The only jewellery permitted is – wrist watch, light chain crucifix, single stud earring or a set of plain stud earrings, one in each ear, worn in the lower ear lobe. We are celebrating our best ever GCSE examination results.
