
Personal Development

Personal Development at Blessed Robert Sutton is everything we do in school in order to ensure students leave with the capacity to maximise their life chances.

Throughout our Personal
Development plan, we link closely
to the British values of "Democracy,
rule of law, individual liberty and
mutual respect and tolerance."
"Justice and trust" are closely
linked to "democracy and the rule
of law". "Individual liberty and
mutual respect and tolerance" are
again closely linked, reflecting the
school's values of "compassion and
forgiveness".

Students are given frequent opportunities to reflect upon both the British Values and our distinct Catholic Values in collective worship, tutor time, lessons and enrichment/cultural opportunities.

Throughout a student's time at school, we provide them with opportunities to reflect upon who they are as a person, what their aspirations are, what they want to do and change and ensure they have all the skills to become the person they want to be. This is highlighted around the school in collective worship, form time, enrichment opportunities and trips.



A Caring School

We believe that Robert Sutton is a very special place to be. Our reputation for knowing and caring for each student as an individual is what attracts many families to our school.

We are a small school with a family feel. We know our students as individuals and understand their strengths and areas for development.

We have a dedicated pastoral team working each day to support all students, which includes Form Tutors, Heads of Year, Pastoral Support Workers, an Assistant Head responsible for Pastoral Care and a dedicated Safeguarding Officer.

We are fully committed to looking at additional innovative ways to care and support all our students. As part of this we were one of the first schools in the country to have Pastoral and Therapy Dogs. Buddy and Hugo work alongside our SENCO, supporting our students and bringing a positive sense of


well-being to the entire school community.

We also pride ourselves on the strong relationships that all staff have with students. Our behaviour system based on collective responsibility and mutual respect is underpinned by our belief in forgiveness and a clean slate. Rewarding effort, manners and progress are essential and our rewards system includes letters home, merit certificates, reward trips, as well as breakfast with the Headteacher for students in each year group.

We believe that tutor time is 'the sixth lesson of the day' and a great deal of time goes into developing a programme that enriches all students. Form Tutors know all students as individuals whilst activities like 'Motivational Monday' and 'Wellbeing Wednesday', as well as regular acts of Collective Worship, mean that our students both enjoy and develop during form time every day.

A Challenging Curriculum

Whilst the national directive on curriculum continues to dictate much of what a child should study to Key Stage 4, at Blessed Robert Sutton we strongly believe in the education of the whole child.

We have a broad and balanced curriculum that supports all learners to successfully move onto progression routes that include Sixth Form and Apprenticeships.

Students study a wide range of courses in keeping with the National Curriculum offering them the opportunity to achieve in a wide spectrum of subjects.

We value all subject areas in the development of children and encourage pupils to create a curriculum that will enable them to pursue their own interests alongside the core subjects.

Religious Education is part of the core curriculum for

all. At Key Stage 3 students begin to select their own pathways of study.

We are dedicated to the physical needs of young people and all of our students participate in Physical Education as part of their core curriculum from Year 7 to Year 11 inclusive.

Our values driven curriculum is enhanced further with an RE and PSHCE curriculum that embraces the development of the whole child, raising their awareness of all aspects of Spirituality, Social Justice and Moral Conduct. This supports students to become well-rounded citizens ready to tackle the challenges of the modern world.

Each child can expect to be taught by a subject expert, who will be continually challenging all learners to achieve their very best. Our staff are all passionate about their subjects and seek to inspire learners with an enthusiasm for each and every subject they are studying.

From Year 6

to Year 7

This is a significant moment for all families. At Robert Sutton we have young people from over 30 different primary schools join us each year and are committed to going the extra mile to ensure that when they join the school they are happy, safe and supported to achieve and succeed.

As part of this we have developed a transition timeline for families. This starts during Year 5 with numerous visits to school to take part in enrichment days.

From June, in Year 6 the programme includes visits to all primary schools by our Head of Year 7. July sees both the Year 6 Induction Evening and Induction Day - and as part of these, parents are provided with a comprehensive Year 6 Transition Booklet containing all key information in one place.

Before October half-term, parents will have benefited from a 'Welcoming Evening' with form tutors and the school's leadership team. In addition, students will have experienced the Team Building days to build friendships and a sense of community within the year group.

Communication

Progress For All

Classes are taught by highly qualified teachers who deliver rigorous lessons aimed at ensuring every student excels.

Our data systems track the progress of students and keep parents updated regularly through Class Charts. Every subject in the school is supported to provide excellent teaching and learning opportunities through having their own designated specialist teaching spaces.

All classrooms are equipped with data projectors or interactive whiteboards. We want to see every student

succeed. Our support and guidance ensures that everyone makes excellent progress.

We fully support our students who have special educational needs and disabilities. We are determined to provide stimulating educational experiences to stretch academically our students who have a real desire for extra challenge.

We believe in the limitless potential of our students and all of our students deserve an education which enables them to be as successful as possible.

Remote Learning

We have developed the use of an extensive range of software to facilitate high quality home learning.

We have worked hard to explore the potential for home learning software to be blended with face to face teaching in an innovative and engaging way. All students have access to the full range of Office 365 software to move seamlessly between learning in and out of the classroom. Digital learning platform Class Charts, books, assessment feedback and online tutorials over MS Teams are used to enhance students' learning experience and ensure that they make sustained academic progress.
